Outlook for WesternNewMexico

Fire

Acreage 18,312. The fire remains active primarily on the east and western flanks, with some movement to the south. No further northern progress is expected.


Smoke

Continued late night/early morning "drainage" smoke in Reserve, Frisco, and the ranch lands south and east of the fire. The smoke plume will drift almost due east, remaining south of NM Route 12 and US 60, including Datil and Magdalena. Light but noticeable impacts Socorro south to Truth or Consequences late afternoon into evening hours.

Other

Smoke-sensitive individuals and people with respiratory or heart disease are encouraged to take precautionary measures.

Air Quality Index (AQI)	Actions to Protect Yourself
● Good	No action required.
● Moderate	Unusually sensitive individuals should consider limiting prolonged or heavy exertion.
● US0	People within Sensitive Groups* should reduce prolonged or heavy outdoor exertion.
● Unhealthy	People within Sensitive Groups* should avoid all physical outdoor activity.
● Very Unhealthy	Everyone should avoid prolonged or heavy exertion.
● Hazardous	Everyone should avoid any outdoor activity.

*Sensitive Groups include children, older adults, pregnant women, and people with pre-existing heart or lung conditions.
